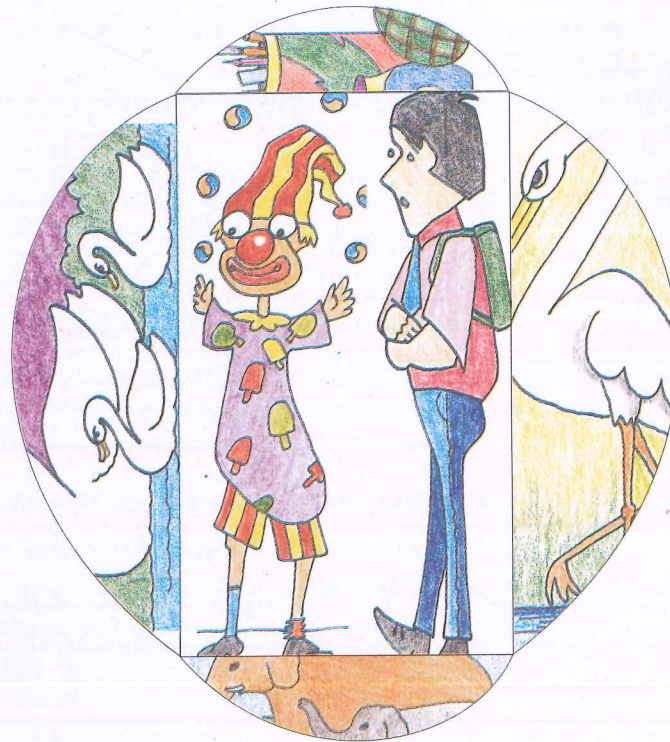

Now let me tell you about the colours of two families.

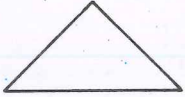
This is yellow family. It has lemon yellow, chrome yellow, ochre yellow, orange, red, light brown and dark brown.

This is blue family. It has violet, dark blue, light blue, dark green and light green.



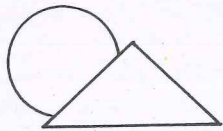

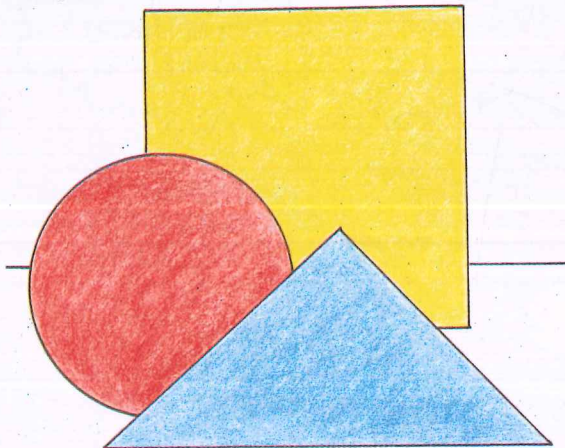


When we show some kind of relation or link between two or more than two objects/figures/forms, we overlap them on each other.

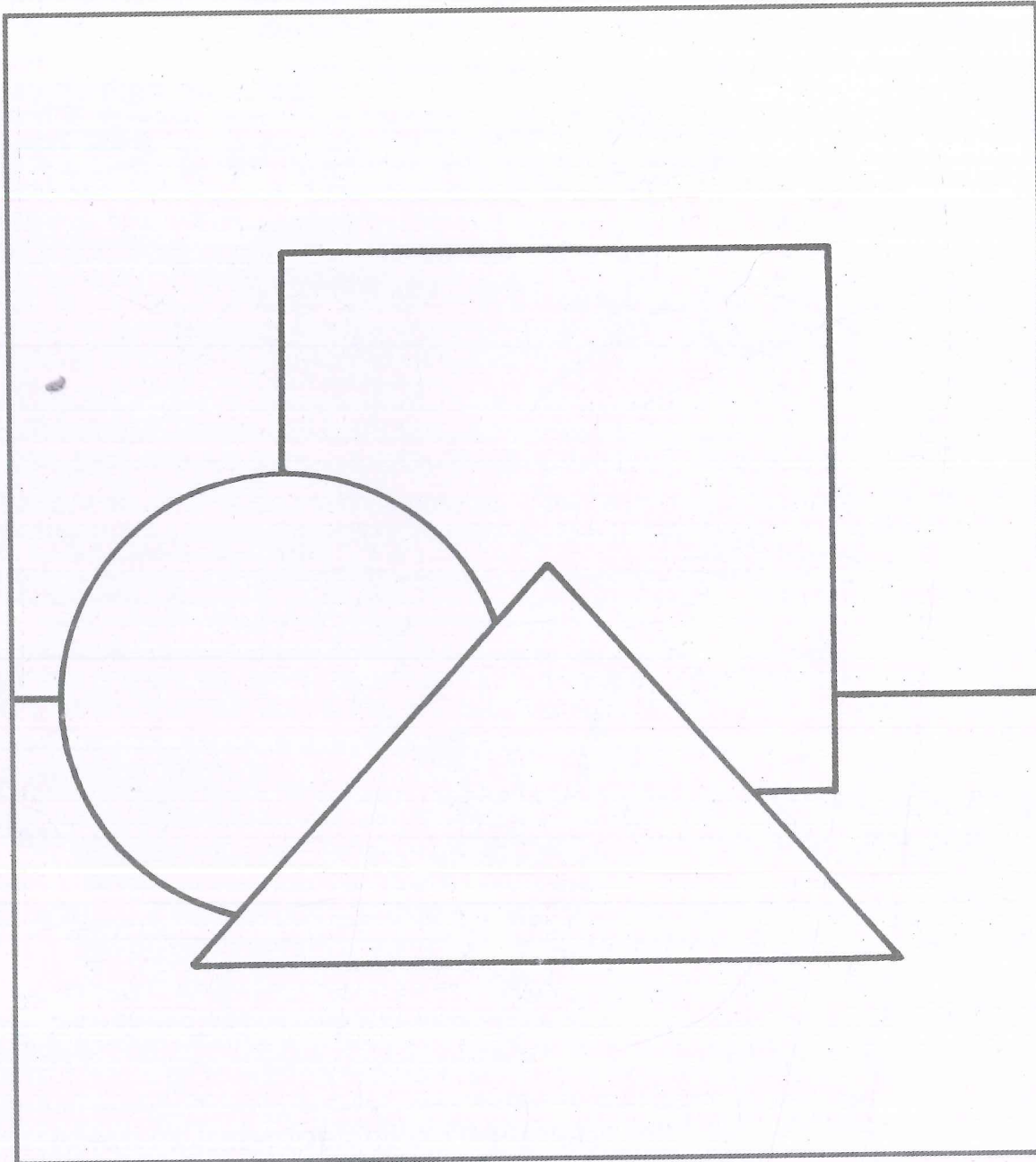

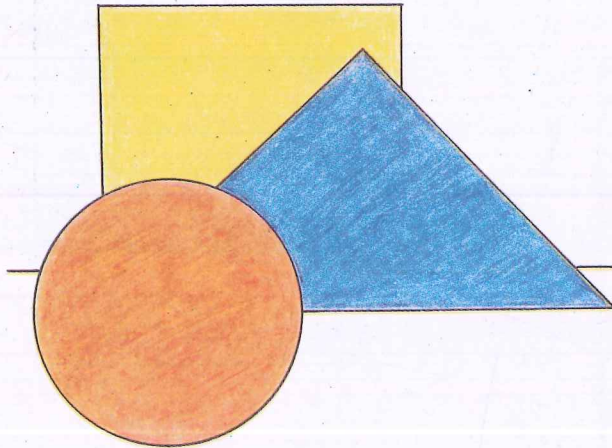

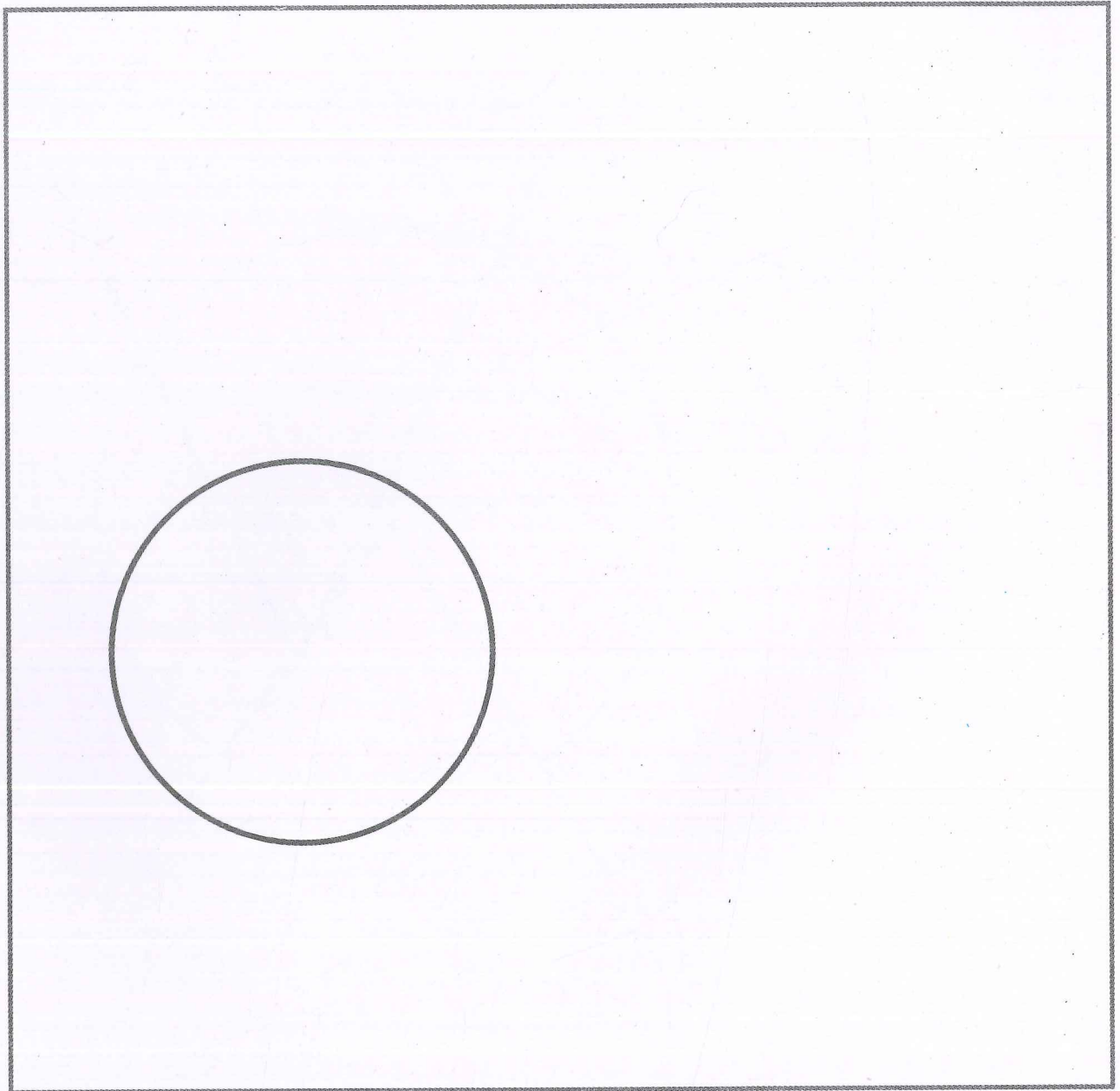
Overlapping

There is a circle in the foreground. Now draw a triangle and a square overlapped by the circle and colour it.



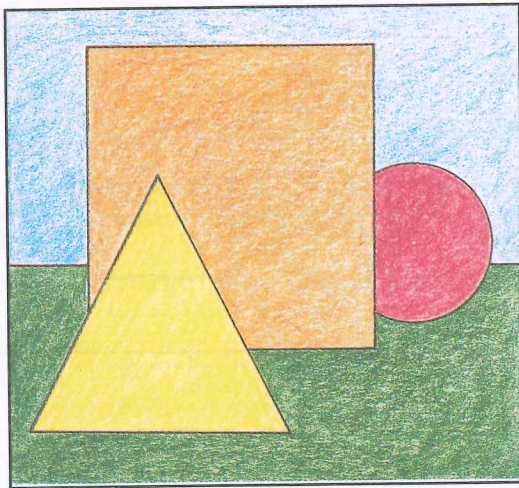

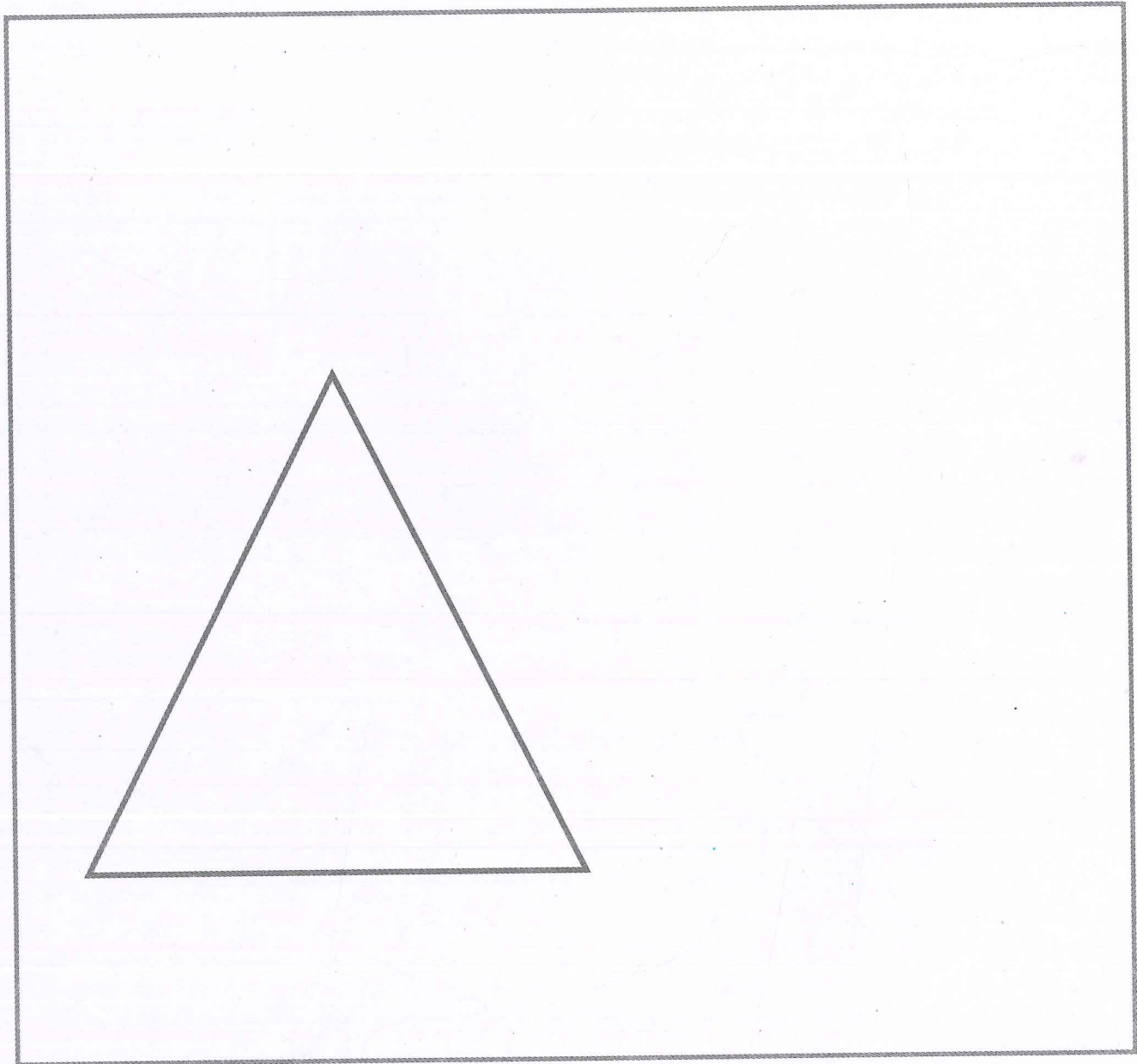

Following the given basic lines, change the placement of the objects shown and then colour it.

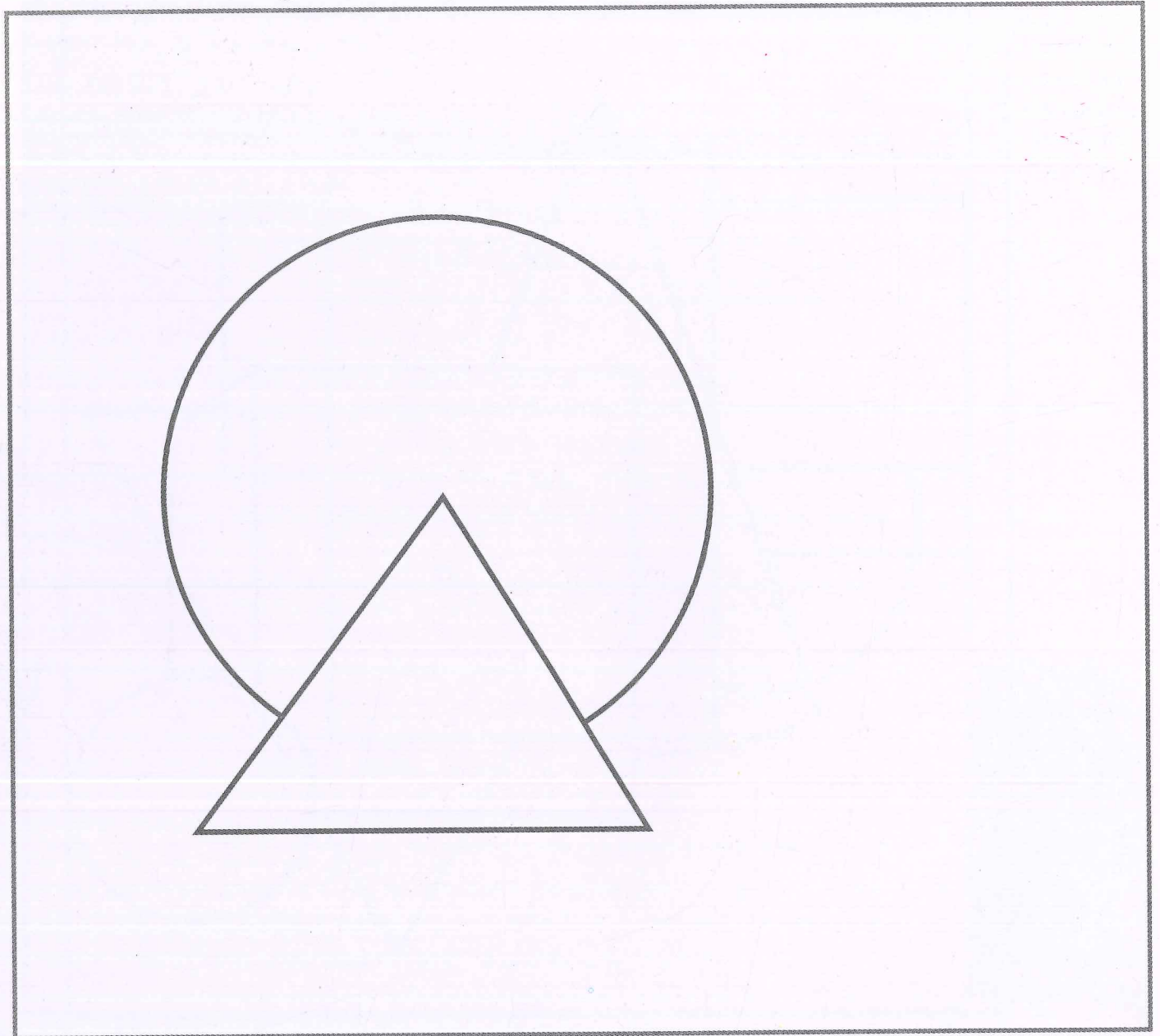
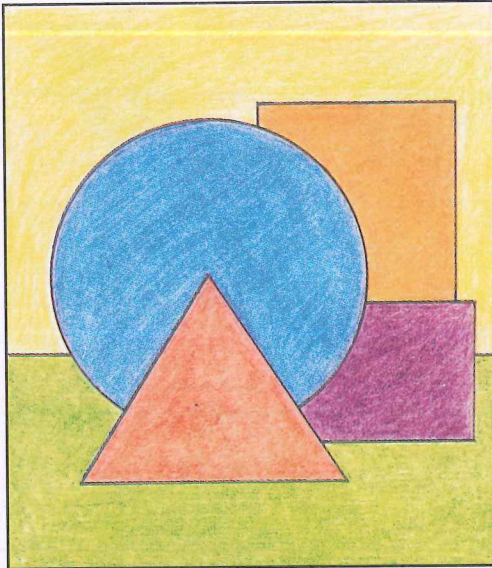
