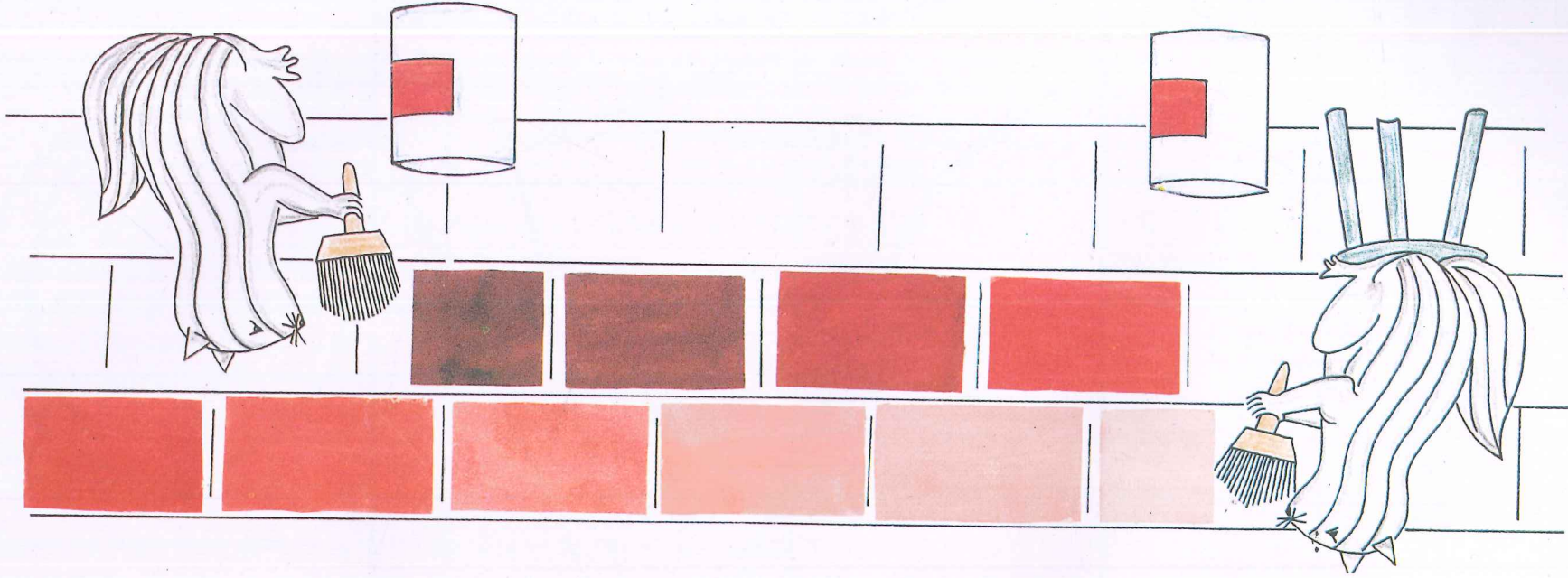


Tint of a colour is defined as the lighter tone of the colour. While using poster colour we add different quantity of white colour to that particular colour so as to get the tint of that colour.

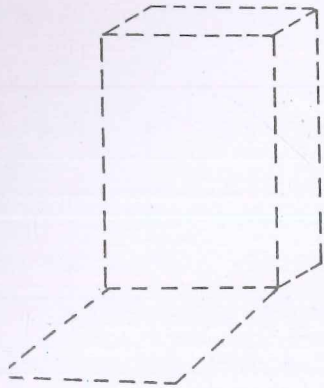
Shade of a colour is defined as the darker tone of the colour. While using poster colour we add different quantity of black colour to that particular colour to get the shade of that colour.



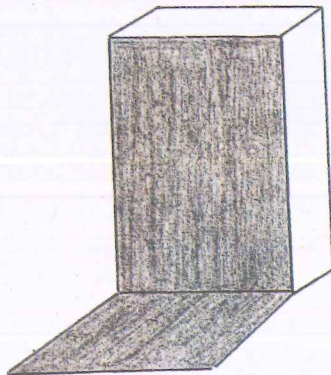
## Pencil Shading

Pencil shading is used to give a 3-D look to an object.

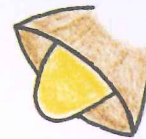
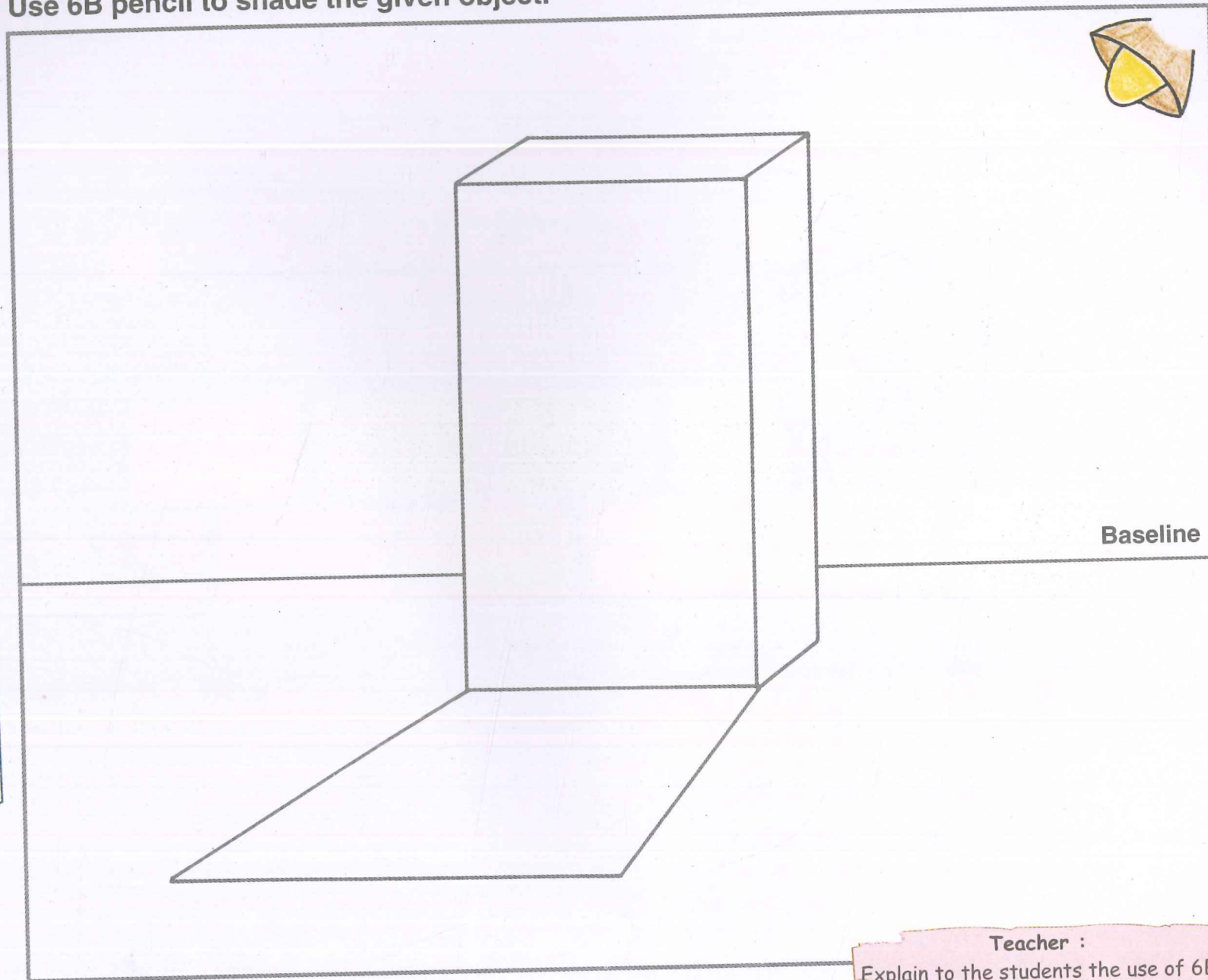
