

Draw and shade a bag and a cap using pencils of different grades in the space provided. The steps of shading would remain the same, as studied in the previous class.






Teacher: Encourage the students to practise the technique of pencil shading using different still life drawings in the drawing file.

Teacher: Encourage the students to practise the technique of oil pastel colouring on different still life drawings adding suitable background in the drawing file.



Teacher: Explain to the students that in monochrome medium of colouring, only one single colour is used to give different tones/shades to objects/figures. Also encourage the students to practise this technique on different drawings in their drawing file.


Draw and colour a mug using different water colours in the space provided. The steps of colouring would be same, as studied in the previous class.





Teacher: Encourage the students to practise the use of water colours on different drawings in their drawing file.

Study carefully the picture of a bottle & a box. Draw and colour the same using both water colours and oil pastels in the space provided.



Teacher: Guide the students to make use of water colours first and then apply oil pastels. Also encourage them to practise the technique of mix media colouring on different objects from their surroundings alongwith the suitable background in the drawing file.

Draw and shade the given flower plant using pencils of different grades in the space provided.




Teacher: Encourage the students to observe carefully the different types of flower plants in the nature and practise the same using pencil shading in the drawing file.

See carefully the given picture of a flower plant. Draw and colour the same using oil pastels of different colours in the space provided.







Study carefully the use of different tones of a single water colour in the given flower plant. Draw & colour the same in the space provided.




Teacher: Encourage the students to practise the same using single water colour of their choice on different types of flower plants in the drawing file.

Study carefully the use of both water colours & oil pastels in the given flower plant. Draw & colour the same in the space provided.




Teacher: Guide the students to use the water colours first & then apply oil pastels. Encourage them to practise the use of mix media on different flower plants in the drawing file.

Draw and shade the given picture of a tree in its natural surrounding using pencils of different grades in the space provided.




Teacher: Encourage the students to observe carefully the different types of trees in their natural surroundings. Draw and shade them using the technique of pencil shading in their drawing file.

Study carefully the picture of a date palm in its natural surrounding. Draw & colour the same using oil pastels of different colours in the space provided.




Teacher: Ask the students to find out different species of plants that grow in desert areas. Encourage them to draw & colour some of them using oil pastels of different colours in their drawing file.
